Key Findings of the Wave Summer 2021

Methodology: quantitative survey of Ukrainian population

Sample size 2,080 respondents

Sample design The interviews were conducted with the residents of Ukraine aged 18 years old and older. Sample design

corresponds to the distribution of adult population of Ukraine by age, sex, oblast and settlement type according to the data of the State Statistics Service of Ukraine as of January 1, 2019 (excluding AR Crimea and

NGCA of Donetska and Luhanska oblasts).

Method CAPI: face-to-face interviews on tablets at respondent's home

Fieldwork dates August-September 2021

Margin of error Margin of sample error (not including design effect) does not exceed 2.2% for national sample. It can

be different for every response to every question in all surveys. On these slides, the margin of error is

shown for each question/option

This is shown on example here.

A is statistically grater than F

K is statistically grater than F

There is no statistical difference between K and A










Q: Did you participate in CSO activities during the last year?
































Q: What can be the first sign of irreversibility of positive changes in Ukraine?




Q: How much you agree or disagree with each of these statements? (1/2)








